

Sensual response

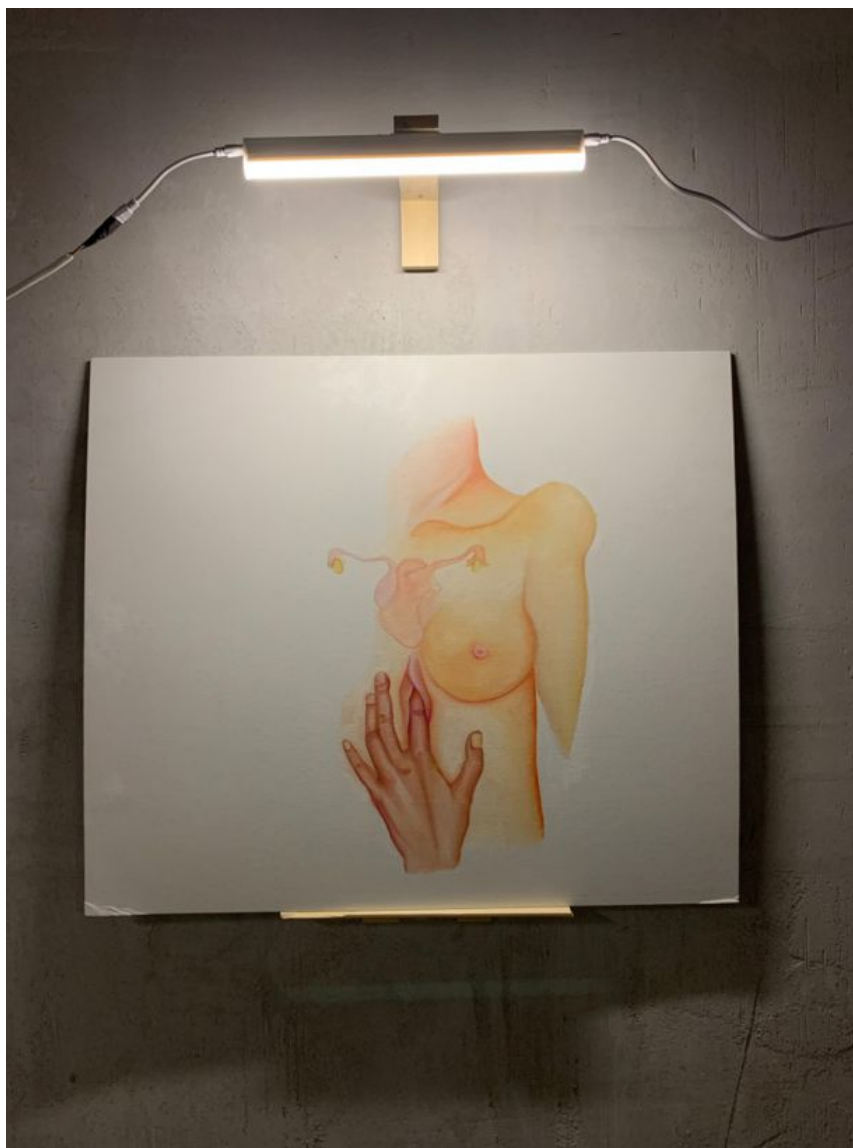

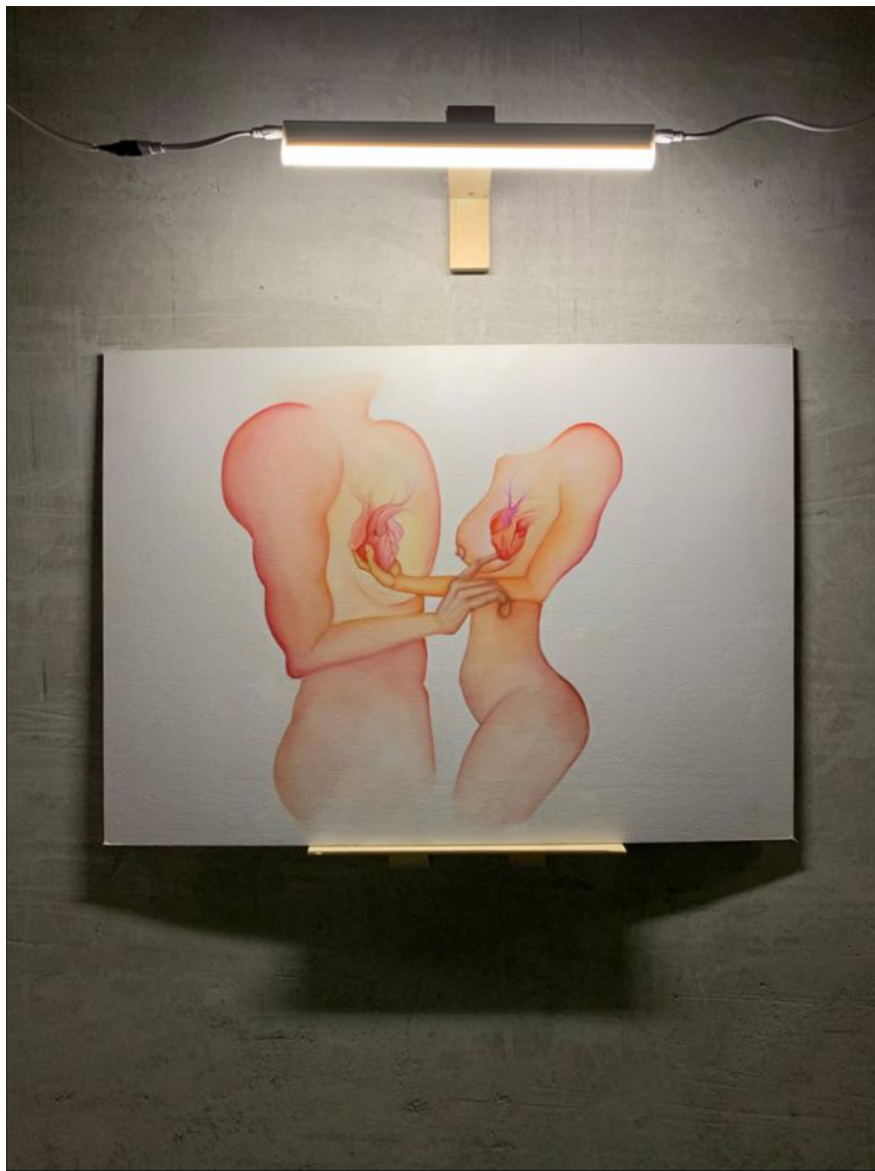

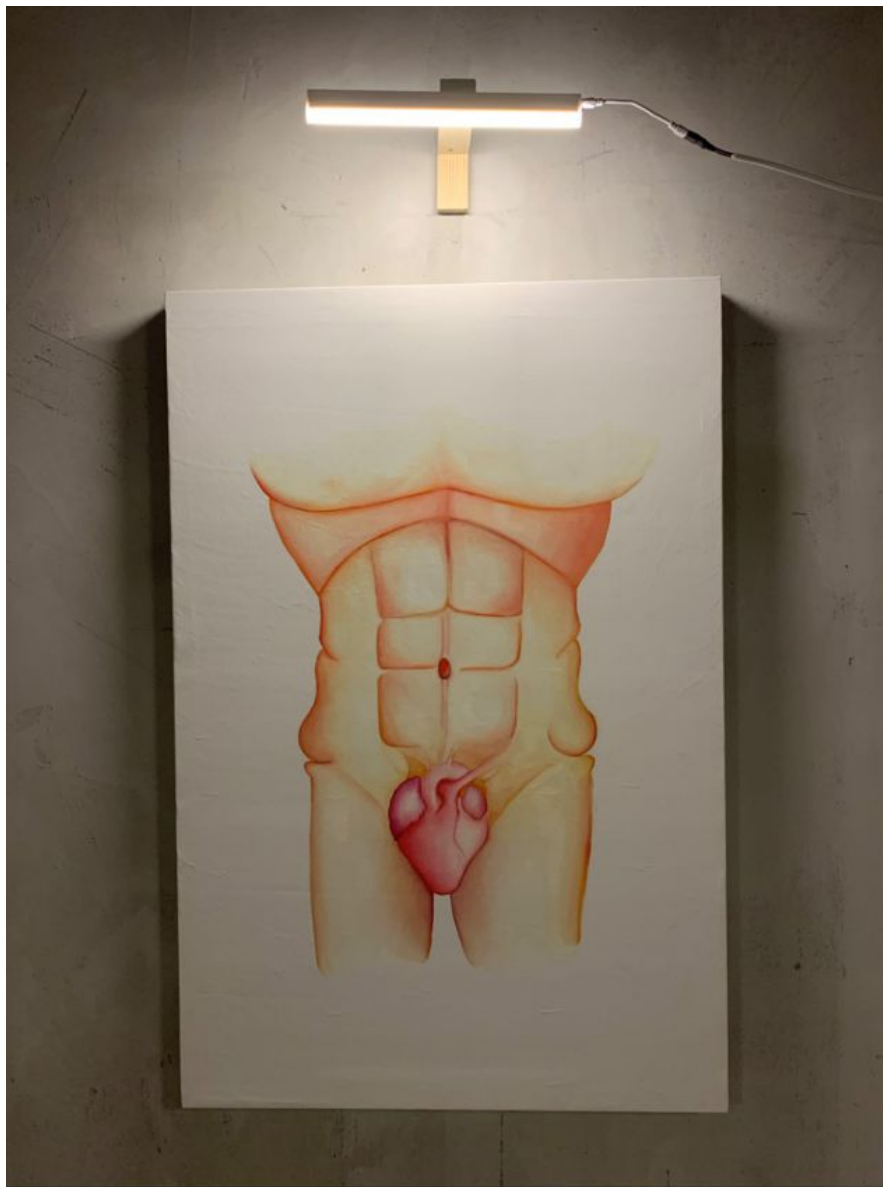
Relationships are the interaction of complex components.

«Naked 2»

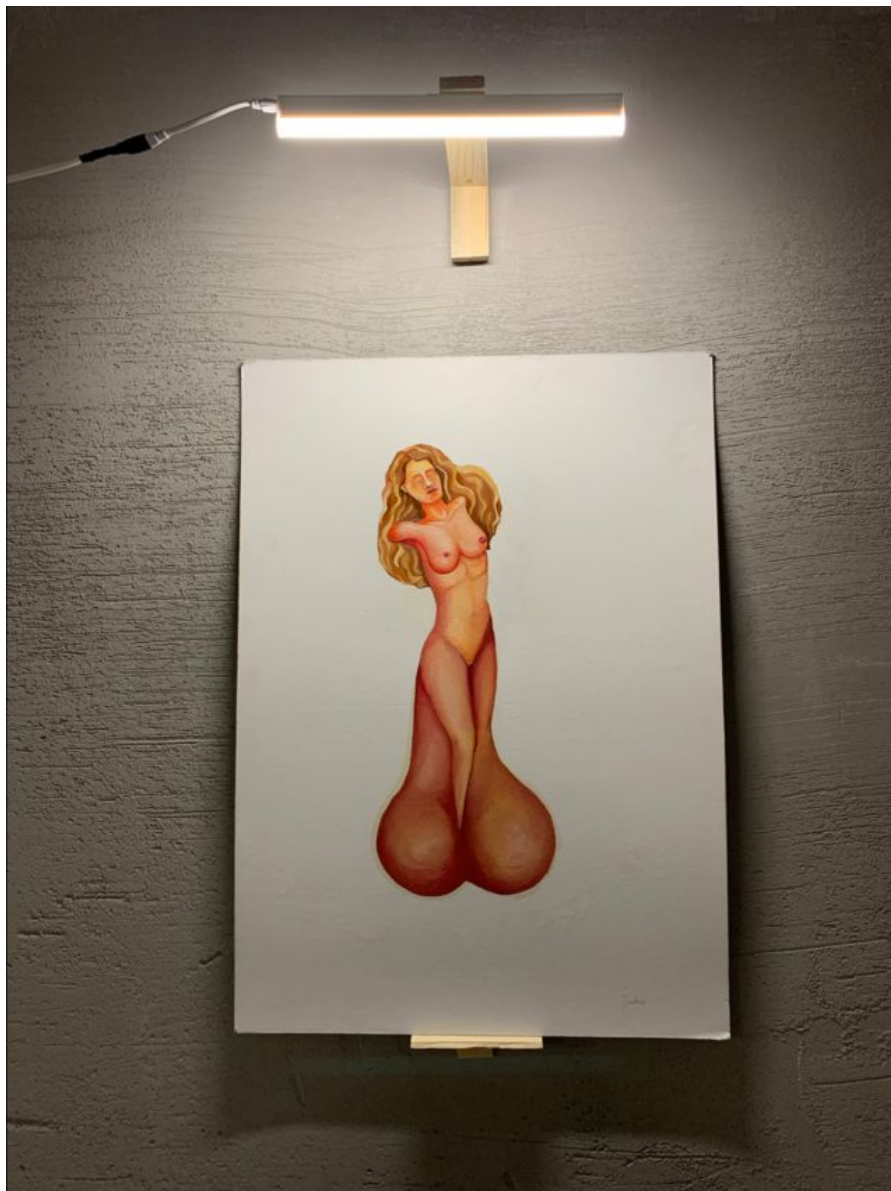
